Payment

Please be sure to pay Flying Dogs Agility directly if you have not completed your payment for the trial. **DO NOT pay online.**

Classes Entered

When you completed your online entry, you received an email from webserver@ukagilityinternational.com with the subject line "Confirmation of entry for Flying Dogs Aug 2019 show". This email contains the information on classes entered.

I have attached a running order. This is only for the purpose of checking your entry. Running order for Masters Agility will be determined by the results of Masters Jumping. The final running order will be posted on the gate sheets.

THERE WILL BE NO CHANGES TO JUMP HEIGHT OR LEVEL THE DAY OF THE TRIAL OR FROM SATURDAY TO SUNDAY, unless it is the result of measurement. PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRY PRIOR TO THE TRIAL DATE.

Changing Handlers

If changing handlers, please let me know so that the results are correct.

Checking In

You do not need to check in unless you need to be measured. All competitors in each class must check in at the gate by checking off their name on the call sheet. If you do not check in, the class will not wait for you. Please only check in for the class being walked. Please remember it is your responsibility to be ready at the ring for your run. While UKI does not require strict running order within your jump height, other than in Masters Series, Flying Dogs will be running dogs in order according to the gate sheet since this is a small, one-ring trial. THERE IS NO RUNNING ORDER FOR THE TRIAL. THE RUNNING ORDER WILL BE ON THE POSTED GATE SHEETS.

Measuring Dogs

Measuring will take place near the check-in table prior to the first class each day. All dogs jumping below the 22 inch Regular height or the 20 inch Select height must have a UKI measurement, if you have not yet had one. Dogs competing above those heights do not need to be measured. **If you have an actual measurement from another organization (such as AKC/USDAA), and wish to use this measurement, please bring your card to the measurer for documentation. The card will need to state the dog's exact height or we are unable to use that to verify your measurement**

Parking/Crating

PARKING IS LIMITED. All parking is first come first served. Please be courteous of other cars. Crating space is very limited inside the building, please stack crates when possible. NO EX PENS ALLOWED. Please be respectful of others. If you choose to work out of your car, the weather is predicted to be mostly sunny but cold this weekend so please plan accordingly. You may set up after 7:30 AM on Saturday/Sunday.

Helpers

This is a small trial and helpers are not only appreciated, but are necessary to conduct a smooth running show. Please help out when you can!

Music may be played during walkthroughs and lightly during running of classes.

There will be no food vendor. Plan to bring your own food/drinks!

Course Maps will be available online by 3 AM each day at k9trialservices.com. Click on the Flying Dogs link With the exception of Masters Series Jumping which will be published upon completion of the previous class.

Online Results

All clear round/ qualifying results will be available to view within 2 weeks of the trial. You will be able to log on to your account and see results that were clear rounds, gaining Level points.

Not for Competition Runs

You may turn any run into a NFC run, but **must declare this right before entering the ring.** You may use a **non audible toy** (NO food, NO clickers). You may use this time for any type of training, as long as you are not abusive to your dog. The handler may use the SCT to train any piece of equipment multiple times. If a handler chooses to train their startline, the time will be started once the handler begins to walk back towards their dog once they have left him. You MUST leave the ring immediately once time is up.

We will be offering an NFC Food Reward Area. Due to this information not being published in the premium, we will allow for full refunds for anyone who wants to withdraw due to this policy. The specifics regarding this rule are as follows:

4.12a NFC Food Reward Area

A food reward area may be available, which is set adjacent to the ring boundary for the purpose of giving food to a dog during an NFC run.

The food area must be fully enclosed by fencing with an opening into the ring where the handler and dog enter. The food may only be delivered within this area.

The opening must have a gate that remains closed during all other runs.

This area may not intrude into the ring boundaries, only set adjacent.

Show managers must apply for the NFC food area option through the UKI office for approval. When the show is granted permission, this option will be published in the show's premium.

The food area must have a table where the food is placed and the food must be stored in a bag or container. A towel or wipes should be made available in the area where the handler can quickly wipe their hands of any crumbs before continuing with their run.

The dog may not leave the area until the food given has been swallowed.

A ring steward must be available to close this area off from the ring upon the end of the NFC run. After each run where the food option has been utilized, the steward should also visibly check the immediate area inside the ring to help ensure nothing has been dropped. If anything is found, the steward must also notify the judge before cleaning up the area.

If any handler is found to have carried, dropped (or their dog has carried or dropped) food in the ring whether accidentally or deliberately, therefore potentially impeding another competitors run, the handler will be unable to use this option for the remainder of the trial with any dog and must be reported to UKI. If a handler has multiple offences, they will be barred from using this option at any further UKI trials.

This option is not allowed for Masters Series Heats, Tournament classes, Cups, Classics and Opens.

Our training facility is located just south of Leesburg, VA, one mile off Route 15 on Evergreen Mills Road, adjacent to Elsie and Richard Maylott's house at 19277 Evergreen Mills Road. Street Address for GPS/Google Maps: 19277 Evergreen Mills Road, Leesburg, VA

From the East Via Route 7: Follow Rt. 7 West towards Leesburg. Take the first exit for Rt. 15 South/Rt. 7 West towards Winchester/Warrenton. After you pass the exit for the Dulles Greenway toll road, take the second Rt. 15 exit, Rt. 15 South towards Warrenton. On Rt. 15 South, turn left at the second traffic light onto Evergreen Mills Road. Follow Evergreen Mills past two schools (one on either side) and Masons Lane (on the right). The training facility entrance is the third driveway on the right after Masons Lane.

From the East Via Dulles Greenway: Follow Dulles Greenway toll road to the end. Take Exit 1A (left lane) for Rt. 15 South/Rt. 7 West towards Leesburg/ Warrenton, which puts you on the Rt.15 Bypass. On the Bypass, take the second Rt. 15 exit, Rt. 15 South towards Warrenton. On Rt. 15 South, turn left at the second traffic light onto Evergreen Mills Road. Follow Evergreen Mills past two schools (one on either side) and Masons Lane (on the right). The training facility entrance is the third driveway on the right after Masons Lane.

From the North: Follow the Rt. 15 Bypass south past Battlefield Shopping Center and the Leesburg Corner outlet shops. After you pass the exit for the Dulles Greenway toll road, take the second Rt. 15 exit, Rt. 15 South towards Warrenton. On Rt. 15 South, turn left at the second traffic light onto Evergreen Mills Road. Follow Evergreen Mills past two schools (one on either side) and Masons Lane (on the right). The training facility entrance is the third driveway on the right after Masons Lane.

From the West: Follow Rt. 7 East towards Leesburg. Take the exit for Rt. 15 towards Leesburg/Warrenton, turn left at the stop sign, then turn right onto Rt. 15 South. Immediately turn left at the next light onto Evergreen Mills Road. Follow Evergreen Mills past two schools (one on either side) and Masons Lane (on the right). The training facility entrance is the third driveway on the right after Masons Lane.

From the South: From Gilberts Corner, follow Rt. 15 North towards Leesburg. About 4 miles past Oatlands Plantation, turn right onto Masons Lane (just past a church on the right). Follow Masons Lane to the stop sign (about a mile), and turn right onto Evergreen Mills Road. The training facility entrance is the third driveway on the right.
