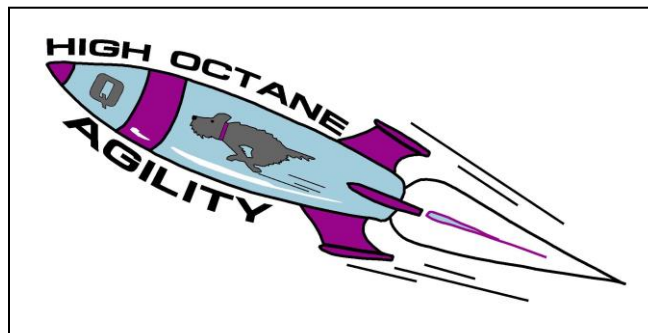

<u>Speedstakes Titling Program</u>	<u>International Titling Program</u>
<p>SS Beginners: For dogs that are not eligible for SS Novice, SS Senior and SS Champion levels in the Speed Stakes Program.</p> <p>SS Novice: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points in the SS Beginners classes. Or a newly registered dog who is eligible for Beginners, but the owner/handler currently runs a Champ level dog in the International Program.</p> <p>SS Senior: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 20 points in the SS Novice classes.</p> <p>SS Champion: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 36 points in the SS Senior classes.</p>	<p>Beginners: For dogs that are not eligible for Novice, Senior and Champion levels in the International Program</p> <p>Novice: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points in Beginners classes. Of those points, 8 must be in agility classes. Or a newly registered dog who is eligible for Beginners, but the owner/handler currently runs a Champ level dog in the International Program.</p> <p>Senior: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 20 points in the Novice classes. Of those points 12 must be obtained in agility classes, 4 from jumping, and 4 from games.</p> <p>Champion: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 36 points in the Senior classes. Of those points 12 must be obtained in agility classes, 12 from jumping, and 12 from games.</p>
<u>Masters Series Tournament Rules</u>	

The Masters is to encourage more competitive running in UKI classes and improve the overall standard of top level agility. The Masters has been created for dogs and competitors whose goal is to compete at both National and International level.

General Rules Open to all UKI Level dogs including Select heights. Separate competition for each height. Agility and Jumping rounds with results combined. Handlers must run in strict running orders, failure to do so will result in elimination. Either Agility or Jumping classes may run first. If a handler has 2 dogs entered within a jump height, they may move their first dog up so that there are as many dogs as possible between their dogs. If this is not possible, they will receive a 6 minute break. If a handler has more than 2 dogs within a jump height and the entry is not large enough for a large enough gap in between all their dogs, the first of their dogs drawn will be allowed to run in between a jump height change, if a jump height change is available before their height. If it is not, the final decision will be made by the judge and show manager, taking into consideration fairness to the competitor and other entrants in the Masters Class. Day of Entries must run first within the running orders of the first class. The second class must run in reverse order of placing from first class. The dog must run in the height that he will compete at in the Masters Final. The same dog and handler must run both rounds. Any extraordinary circumstances to be ruled by UKI.

Scoring Standard UK Agility Marking will apply. Faults converted into seconds. 5 faults = 5 seconds. Time faults treated the same as course faults. An elimination = 100 faults plus 60 second course time. An absent or NFC run = 1000 faults with a 60 second course time. Dogs with an absent or NFC run in either the Agility or Jumping will forfeit any Q's or awards gained in the other round; in other words, both rounds must be run for competition. Dogs with double elimination will not be placed. An E in the individual round will not be placed in that round. Dogs with the lowest score will be deemed the winner. In the event of a tie, the Agility result will be the deciding factor.

Final Qualification –Final Qualification –2 ways to qualify for the Final to be held at the UKI US Open: A. Individual Winners (per height) of the Masters Agility or Masters Jumping class (even if an E is earned in the other round). B. 1st & 2nd Overall (per height) ([neither round may have an elimination](#)). Only the handler who qualifies the dog through a Masters Heat, may run the dog in the Final. A **Last Chance Masters Heat** will be available at the UKI US Open if you do not qualify at a local Masters Heat

Prizes Of the Prize entry fee; \$5.00 is placed in heat prize fund. Each height has its own prize fund and will be divided as per Masters "Prize Money Guide". Prize fund is for overall winners only. **In the event there is not a monetary winner within a height, the prize money will be sent to UKI to be added to the Masters Final.** \$1 from each entry fee will be split & placed in the Final prize fund and Team USA WAO fund.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

UK Agility International Rules and Regulations apply to the whole event and all people and dogs must comply with these at all times. As a competitor it is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations as they stand at the time of the show. This show will run under the current edition UK Agility International rules found on the UKI web page.

All dogs and handlers must be registered with UK Agility International in order to compete. UK Agility International's official rules & regulations are given free on registration of Handler/Owner to UKI. If you or your dog is not already registered, fill out the UKI registration form included in this schedule and add the registration fee to your entry fee, or for reduced fee, register online at www.ukagilityinternational.com

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of **UK Agility International rules and regulations** including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete in UK Agility International Trials, with the exception of dogs over 15 calendar months of age eligible to compete in Nursery Classes & Speedstakes.

Entries without fees paid in full will be returned. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or Guardian if the competitor is a minor.

Refund Policy Entries will not be accepted, changed or altered after the closing date or capping level has been reached except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A full refund is available for any membership that is not older than 14 days from the creation of the account date. A full refund is available before the closing date or capping level is met for any show. There will be no cost if refund money is to be left in your UKI account. If a refund is requested, then the following administration costs will be incurred. If payment was received by check or money order, then a \$4 administration fee will be incurred. If payment was received by credit card a 4% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction. If payment was received from a Pay Pal account, a 4% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction. Once a show has been closed and/or capped refunds of any kind for any reason will not be available. ***After the closing date, a partial entry may be available for extraordinary circumstances, but this lies with the individual show management based upon their own policies. Contact the show management for details, NOT UKI.***

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition without refund if it is: suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, interfering with the safety of any person or other animal or if it is likely to cause itself damage or suffering if it continues competing. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn and neither in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal providing this was within accordance of UK Agility International rules and regulations.

It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Handlers working more than one dog in a class **must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn.** Failure to do so will result in elimination.

It is expressly understood that **Competitors alone are responsible** for the behavior of their dogs, children and guests. Any competitor whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the show management, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, guests from the event grounds. No refunds of fees will be made in such a case.

No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.

Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the show management reserves the right to appoint another judge. Should circumstances so dictate the show manager, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to UK Agility International. In the event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond our control, the SHOW MANAGEMENT may defray such expenses from the entry fee to cover the cost of the show preparation. These accounts will then be made public.

All competitors **MUST** clean up after their dogs at all times. Failure to do so will result in competitors being asked to leave the Show.

Dogs left in hot cars, or dogs appearing to be in distress, will be dealt with as seen fit by the Show Management.

Media Rights Release: Through the entry into this event, all competitors grant to UKI and its affiliated companies, representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media known now or in the future. Further, I hereby release UKI and its affiliates, representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

Rules of Conduct: UKI promotes dog agility pursuant to regulations consistent with international standards as a competitive, spectator sport. All competitors, officials, and event personnel shall conduct themselves in a professional and sportsmanlike manner consistent with the foregoing statement of purpose and seek to uphold, and enhance where possible, the image of the sport and UKI through such conduct and actions. Each competitor acknowledges through their entry to the UKI event that their participation is a privilege and not a right. By virtue of their entry, competitors acknowledge and agree to comply with all UKI rules and regulations, and agree to accept any sanctions that may be imposed for failure to comply. The judge has responsibility for determining when it is appropriate to excuse a dog and competitor from the ring based on matters related to competitor misconduct. The UKI show officials have responsibility for determining when an infraction should result in expulsion of a competitor, dog, or any person from the event by conducting the procedure outlined in the UKI rule book. UKI head officials, through further investigation, may impose sanctions including suspension or expulsion from future events.

The following is a partial list of infractions on which the judge or UKI officials may take action: Abuse of a dog on the grounds • Actions that may have the appearance of abuse of a dog • Willful misconduct or interference with a competitor's right to show • Any acts of poor sportsmanship • Violation of procedural rules • Compulsive, correctional training on the grounds • Willful misrepresentation on entry forms • Willful misrepresentation of animals • Dog aggression • Failure to exercise diligence in the control of the behavior of their dog. • Intimidation and/or impolite confrontation of judges, event officials, event helpers, or other competitors • Creating excessive delays as a failure to respect the authority of event officials.

In addition, a social media code of conduct is in effect. Cyber bullying of any kind towards event management, UKI, competitors, judges, helpers or volunteers will not be tolerated. Examples of cyber bullying include but are not limited to, communications that seek to intimidate, manipulate, falsely discredit, put down, try to control, rudely confront, demand, and comments that try to incite further issues. Any of these cases may sanction removal from all associated social media pages and even lead to expulsion of UKI events and even further expulsion of organization membership.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. **There will be a \$39.00 service charge for returned checks.** Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made before a competitor may compete. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls to a UK Agility International account must be paid prior to the start of the event. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice shall be reported to UK Agility International. UK Agility International will suspend a dog's/handlers' registration until fees are paid in full. If your UK Agility International account owes money when we process the entries for this show please be sure you have arranged payment to be made directly to the show. Failure to do this will result in your UKI account being suspended.

All dogs are entered at this show at their owners' risk and whilst every care will be taken the show management and UKI will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.

Bitches in season may run at this show. You must notify the show secretary as early as possible to this fact. All BIS must run at the end of the class, after all jump heights have finished in that class and must use a mat on the start line, to be provided by the show. In season pants may be worn while running but handlers allow this at their own risk.

High Octane Agility, LLC Event Protocol during COVID-19

This is subject to change before or after closing date. Final updates will be sent as they are made. You will also be required to sign a waiver electronically before final admission the show.

1. If you have had COVID-19, you may not attend unless you have had a negative test. If you have been exposed to COVID-19, you may not attend within 14 days since exposure.
2. Temperature of each person will be taken with a no contact thermometer. Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 will be asked to leave and will not be able to participate.
3. Exhibitors arriving late, must check in with trial secretary to have their temperature taken. It is exhibitors responsibility to have their temperature taken prior to running in any class. Failure to do so will result in elimination score from the class(es).
4. Dedicated workers and current workers are permitted in the building.
5. There will be limited spectator chairs available with wipes. Please wipe chair after your use. If a chair is not available, you may not be in the spectating area.
6. Pennsylvania is limited to 25 people inside the building. We will be monitoring to make sure we are in compliance and may ask you to leave the building at any time. We may also ask you to move apart if you are not maintaining proper social distancing.
7. Participant chairs are not permitted in the spectator area.
8. Weather permitting, gate will be outside. Dog running and dog on deck will be inside.
9. Warm up jump will be located outside.
10. Crating will not be permitted in the building. Weather permitting, exhibitors may setup EZ-UP style tents to the left of the building.
11. Running orders, courses and scores will be posted online at www.k9trialservices.com
12. No guests or unentered persons allowed on the premises without permission from the trial manager/secretary.
13. We will be designating an entry door and an exit door.
14. There will be no hospitality (beverage and food will not be supplied or available to participants)
15. Masks must be worn at all times on the premises with the following exception:
 - a. Exhibitors may choose to run without masks. Your mask must remain on until AFTER you place your leash in the basket and BEFORE you retrieve your leash from the basket (see #18 below). You MUST keep your mask on your person while running.
 - b. Judge
16. Exhibitors must bring their own mask. Masks will not be available.
17. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be available, but it is highly recommended that exhibitors bring their own
18. Walkthroughs will be limited to 20 people maximum. Please try to maintain a six foot distance during all walkthroughs. Masks must be worn during walkthroughs.
19. Upon entering the ring, exhibitors will place leash/toy in a basket and the basket will be moved to the exit.
20. Ribbons will be handed out in person at the end of the day.
21. If you have been in one of the following states in the previous 14 days of the trial, you are not permitted to enter as you need to be in quarantine per Governor's order: Click link to see current list of states <https://www.health.pa.gov/topics/disease/coronavirus/Pages/Travelers.aspx>
22. Failure to abide by these protocols will be grounds for immediate dismissal.
23. Exhibitors will be required to re-read and agree to any updated COVID-19 policies and waiver the week prior to the trial.
24. If exhibitor is laboratory confirmed COVID-19 positive within 14 days of attending the trial, you will notify the show secretary @ danburke8868@gmail.com
