- 1) Thank you for entering our trial. We have just over 400 runs for the weekend with Saturday being the larger day.
- 2) On the COVID front.
 - a) If you have not already done so, please review and complete our online COVID-19 form. This can be found at https://highoctaneagility.regfox.com/uki-october-2020
 - b) Everyone should have your temperature taken on arrival.
 - c) We have hand sanitizer at various locations around the building. Please sanitize your hands often.
 - d) Please maintain proper social distancing when possible.
 - e) Face Masks must be worn at all times while on the trial site, with the exception of when you are running your dog. Masks must remain on your person while running (i.e. do not put your mask in the basket with your leash).
 - f) No more than 25 people are allowed in the building at any time. We will split walkthroughs if needed to maintain this requirement.
 - g) We will be using the "basket running" method for leashes this weekend. There will be a box at the ring entrance, place your leash in the basket and the "runner" will take the basket to the exit gate. If your leash is not in the basket it will NOT be taken to the exit.
 - h) No exhibitor chairs allowed in the building. We have setup a few chairs at social distancing for your use. Please do not move those chairs and please wipe down after using them. Thank you.
 - i) Maximum of 2 people at a time in each bathroom.
- 3) Limiting crating is available in the red building. We have marked areas for your use to assist in maintaining proper social distancing.
- 4) Mary Ellen Barry is our Corona Protocol Enforcement Officer (CPEO) this weekend. Please follow her "recommendations" for following proper Covid protocol. Just as a warning, I'm starting the rumor she broke her toe by kicking people not maintaining proper social distancing and has a broken finger from dragging people by the hair back to the hand sanitizer because the walked by it without sanitizing. Just a warning!!!
- 5) Property boundaries: If you do not know the boundaries, please find Dan, Maureen, or Mary Ellen for the information.
- 6) Ribbons are self serve. There is a bottle of hand sanitizer next to the ribbon container. Please sanitize prior to opening the drawer and removing your ribbon.

- 7) UKI does not require a strict running order with the exception of Masters Series classes, however we will be trying to run in the order listed on the run order/gate sheets.
