THERE CAN BE NO CHANGES REGARDLESS OF FAULT AFTER THE RUNNING ORDER IS AVAILABLE (BY THURSDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2021). ANY CHANGES AFTER THE RUNNING ORDER IS AVAILABLE WILL BE ASSESSED A \$5 FEE PER CHANGE PAYABLE TO HIGH OCTANE AGILITY REGARDLESS OF FAULT

Double check your dog's registration number, jump height and level of class entered. If you indicated a specific pairs partner and it is not correct, please contact me ASAP.

DO NOT WAIT TO SEE THE RUN ORDER AS PRINTING HAS BEEN DONE BY THEN AND YOU WILL BE ASSESSED A FEE FOR ANY CHANGES

Social Distancing & COVID-19 Safety Measures

We are pleased to offer an opportunity for competitors and others to get out and enjoy events with their dogs. So that we do not risk any setbacks that may impact future events, please join us in following safe practices recommended by the U.S. Center for Disease Control and other State and local health agencies:

1. If you have had COVID-19, you may not attend unless you have had a negative test. If you have been exposed to COVID-19, you may not attend within 14 days since exposure.
2. Masks must be worn by all exhibitors, regardless of vaccination status, when indoors except when running.
3. Exhibitors may choose to run without a mask, however the mask must be removed after entering the ring, remain on your person while running, and be put back on prior to leaving the ring.
4. Warm up jump will be located outside.
6. Running orders, courses and scores will be posted online at <https://k9trialservices.com>.
7. Weather permitting, doors will be open to aid in ventilation.
8. There will be no hospitality (beverage and food will not be supplied or available to participants)
9. Exhibitors must bring their own mask. Masks will not be available.
10. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be available, but it is highly recommended that exhibitors bring their own.
11. Upon entering the ring, exhibitors will place leash/toy in a basket and the basket will be moved to the exit.
12. Ribbons will be self-serve. Please sanitize your hands before touching the ribbon container.
13. Failure to abide by these protocols will be grounds for immediate dismissal.

By all means, if you have been exposed to anyone who may have been exposed or infected with a virus or flu within two weeks prior to the event, or if you are feeling ill, please self-isolate and stay home, knowing that we will happily welcome you at a future trial.

TRIAL SITE INFORMATION & GENERAL RULES

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POTTY AREA for humans will be indoors in the green (original) metal building. No dogs are allowed in the restrooms.

POTTY AREA for the dogs is to the right side of the red metal building (where the fabric building used to be). Please do not let your dogs potty on or near the buildings, this includes the area between the buildings. There will be a \$10 fine assessed to anyone not using the designated potty area.

Absolutely no competitors/dogs are allowed to the left side as you are coming up the long driveway.

The building will be open at 7:00 am both days. **Exhibitors should not arrive prior to 7:00 am.**

There is no exhibitor set up of any kind on Friday night.

Measuring and check-in will be from 7:00 am to 7:45 am both days.

Judging will begin at 8:00 am both days.

Orchard Hills is located on private property and is NOT open to the public outside of event hours. Waiting on the driveway or on Church Street prior to the facility opening is not allowed. The premises are closed 30 minutes after the last run or when the show committee leaves for the day and all competitors must exit by that time.

Admission on the premises outside of stated hours is not permitted and is considered trespassing. If you need access to the property outside of stated hours due to extenuating circumstances, you will need to obtain permission of the show chairperson and/or the property owner. If you find yourself arriving early for the event, there is a Turkey Hill north on 100 and Redners and Dunkin Donuts south on 100.

Competitors must be present with dogs immediately following the class in which an award is earned in order to claim prizes and awards. All prizes and awards must be claimed on the day awarded.

Dogs must remain on leash at all times except when competing in the ring or in the warm up area.

No celebratory balloons are permitted on the premises. These have caused damage to the fans inside the buildings in the past.

No portable propane heaters are permitted in either building.

PARKING AND CRATING

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All kenneling and parking will be restricted to designated areas.

LIMITED Crating is only permissible in the green building for this trial.....Crating inside the building is first come, first serve. NO EXHIBITOR SETUP for crating on Friday night. We are asking our exhibitors to only crate in the building if **ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY**.

Please respect our crating and parking assistants, your cooperation is expected.

Obey the speed limit when driving on North Church Street. Police have been known to issue tickets for speeding.

UPDATE TO TEST SCHEDULE

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We will be allowing Bitches in Season (BIS) and Fix & Continue at this trial in accordance with USDAA policies available at: http://usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm under Official USDAA Policy Statements.

For BIS, we will allow WELL FITTING sanitary britches (no droopy drawers!!) or starting on a mat (please bring your own) BIS will run in their assigned order in the run order with a BIS marked beside their name. Please let the gate steward know for all BIS so that we can mark them appropriately. For Standard classes, all BIS will run at the end of the class and the table will be cleaned before the next class.

BIS must wear sanitary britches when they are on the event grounds at all times except when in the potty area or when, if the competitor decides to start on a mat, at the practice jump or when in the competition ring. BIS should be kenneled away from the other dogs to the extent possible. The handler should exercise good sportsmanship by minimizing the exposure of their BIS to other dogs and limiting their movements about the grounds. Please see the official policy statement for full explanation.

For Fix & Continue, the competitor will be allowed to immediately repeat any obstacle (other than a spread hurdle or long jump) if it is faulted or if the dog, in the competitor's sole discretion, did not meet their desired performance criteria, thereby incurring an elimination. The competitor may repeat one or more relevant preceding obstacles prior to the point of error if it beneficial to their performance of the obstacle. A Fix and Continue may be employed only once during a run. Once an elimination has been scored, the maximum course time shall be retroactively established at 60 seconds. Please see the official policy statement for full explanation.

VENDORS

FOOD

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There will be no food vendor on site, please plan accordingly.

RV PARKING

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Overnight RV parking was limited and required to be reserved. All spots have been reserved, so please do not plan on any overnight parking if you have not already reserved your spot.

MOVE UPS

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Day to day move ups are offered at this trial.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited, and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move ups will NOT be accepted on Saturday for Saturday classes or on Sunday for Sunday classes and you may not withdraw from a class, add a class, or change the program in which a dog is competing due to a move up.

Move up forms will be available in a binder at the ribbon table and must be filled out within 30 minutes of the completion of the last class on Saturday.

If the notation for Pairs/Team says "Not Entered", then this dog was not entered in Pairs/Team this trial.

If you indicated a specific pairs partner on your entry and it is not listed, please contact me ASAP and I will make the change.

CHECK-IN AND MEASURING

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There will be two types of check-in and measuring: Full service and Express.

Each dog is a separate entry so just because one dog does not need to check-in/measure does not mean all of your dogs entered are eligible to do so.

Full service check-in is required if you did not provide a photocopy of a height card or printout from the USDAA site for each dog. Those who cannot present their permanent or completed temporary USDAA cards, or USDAA issued check-in letter, or whose dogs are NOT jumping the maximum height, will be required to measure-in;. Any who have not been measured or checked-in prior to running may forfeit their runs. Bring your dogs that need measuring AND their temporary height cards (the blue ones) to the measuring line BEFORE getting in the check-in line.

Also, if you are due a refund, or still owe us money, please use full service check-in. If you do owe us money, this must be paid at time of check-in or you will not be permitted to run.

Express check-in is required and available for those who provided photocopies of the plastic yellow or white height cards. You must check yourself in and verify your Registration number; if you missed verifying it in your confirmation, this will be your final chance to do so.

We will not be providing copies of running orders for each competitor. Running orders will be available by Wednesday evening for you to download and print at www.k9trialservices.com

We will not be providing printed copies of course maps for each competitor. Course maps will be available after 11pm each evening for the next days classes for you to download and print at www.k9trialservices.com.
