High Octane Agility, LLC Event Protocol during COVID-19

This is subject to change prior to the trial date. Final updates will be sent as they are made.

- 1. If you have had COVID-19 recently, you may not attend unless you have had a negative test. If you have been exposed to COVID-19, you may not attend within 14 days since exposure.
- 2. Temperature of each person will be taken with a no contact thermometer. Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 will be asked to leave and will not be able to participate.
- 3. Dedicated workers and current workers are permitted in the building.
- 4. There will be limited spectator chairs allowed in the arena based on PA Dept of Health guidelines.
- 5. We will be monitoring the number of people inside the arena at any one time to make sure we are in compliance PA DOH guidelines and may ask you to leave the building at any time. We may also ask you to move apart if you are not maintaining proper social distancing.
- 6. Warm up jump will be located outside.
- 7. Crating will NOT be allowed inside the building.
- 8. Running orders, courses and scores will be posted online at www.k9trialservices.com
- 9. No guests or unentered persons allowed on the premises without permission from the trial manager/secretary.
- 10. Weather permitting, arena doors will be open to aid in ventilation.
- 11. There will be no hospitality (beverage and food will not be supplied or available to participants)
- 12. Masks must be worn at all times on the premises.
- 13. Exhibitors must bring their own mask. Masks will not be available.
- 14. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be available, but it is highly recommended that exhibitors bring their own.
- 15. A port-a-pot will be used for exhibitors. As this will be an area of high traffic, please sanitize your hands before and after use.
- 16. Walkthroughs will be limited to 20 people maximum. Please try to maintain a six foot distance during all walkthroughs. Masks must be worn during walkthroughs.
- 17. Upon entering the ring, exhibitors will place leash/toy in a basket and the basket will be moved to the exit.
- 18. Ribbons will be self-serve. Please sanitize your hands before touching the ribbon container.
- 19. We will be following the Travel Guidelines as issued by the PA Department of Health. Current guidelines can be found by clicking the following link https://www.health.pa.gov/topics/disease/coronavirus/Pages/Travelers.aspx
- 20. Failure to abide by these protocols will be grounds for immediate dismissal.
