#### <u>Important</u>

#### **Mask Policy**

We will be requiring masks to be worn by everyone while indoors (including walkthroughs, awards, etc). Masks are optional while running your dogs, however we highly recommend that unvaccinated persons remained masked at all times indoors. You must keep your mask on your person if you remove it while running - i.e., you may not leave it with your leash or put it down on any surfaces, etc.

#### **Indoor Crating**

There will be no indoor crating or personal chairs allowed by competitors. We are discouraging any and all areas of congregation. Handlers running multiple dogs may bring an additional crate to have outside the ring. This crate is to be used ONLY when the competitor is running one of their other dogs and is not to be used for all day crating. We are very sorry for any inconvenience this causes. Please remember that you are welcome to bring your own shade tents.

In an attempt to cut down on areas of congestion, we will be utilizing the Agility Gate app, developed by Roger Ly. This app can be downloaded and used on both android and IOS devices. The app allows you to check in, scratch, or to indicate your run as NFC from your device. You can also check to see which dog is currently running. #### Scoring

Please note that any scoring discrepancies MUST be brought to the attention of Diann Gastley or Marianne Pieper within 30 minutes of the completion of any class.

#### **Running Orders**

The running orders for the preliminary rounds is attached to this email. It will also be available at <u>www.k9trialservices.com</u> by noon on Thursday. The first rounds of each event will be random, with adjustments made for handlers with multiple dogs. If you do not have a gap of 10 dogs in between multiple dogs, see Diann Gastley, Dan Burke, Mary Ellen Barry or Marianne Pieper to move one of your dogs. You may NOT move in the running order without the permission of one of those people. If we are not able to create a 10 dog gap, you will be given 6 minutes. The 6-minute countdown will start as the handler's first dog crosses the finish line; the handler must enter the ring with their second dog before the countdown is complete.

Final rounds will be run in reverse seed order. In the seeded classes, a handler must notify Diann or Marianne within 30 minutes of the results being posted of the previous class in that particular event if they wish to move their running order for the next round or be given a 6 minute break. Failure to do so will mean they will be moved.

#### **Parking/Crating**

There is no crating in the buildings due to COVID. You may work out of your car and/or set up a shade tent. All parking is first come first served. Please be respectful of the parking attendants. Parking is in 2 areas; the first area is front of the red building, 2 rows will fit there. There is no parking in front of these 2 rows or in front of the sheep pens. You may also park to the side of the green building in the old outdoor ring.

#### Site Information

Orchard Hills is located on private property and is NOT open to the public outside of trial hours. DO NOT arrive at the trial site prior to stated times. Waiting in the driveway or on Church Street is not allowed. If you

find yourself arriving early, there is a Turkey Hill North on 100 and a Render's and Dunkin Donuts South on 100.

Music will be played during walkthroughs and lightly during running of classes.

## Food

There will not be a food vendor for lunch nor will there be any food/snacks available due to COVID. Water will be available for workers.

#### **Measuring Dogs**

Measuring will take place near the main ring prior to the first class. All dogs jumping below the 22 inch Regular height or the 20 inch Select height must have a UKI measurement, if you have not yet had one. Dogs competing above those heights do not need to be measured. If you have an actual measurement from another organization (such as AKC), and wish to use this measurement, please bring your card to the measurer for documentation. The card will need to state the dog's exact height or we are unable to use that to verify your measurement

## **Helpers**

Help from competitors is not only appreciated, but is necessary to conduct a smooth running show. Please see our ring managers Jacky Mento and Kathleen Schaefer if you are able to help.

## **Online Results**

All clear round/ qualifying results will be available to view at <u>www.ukagilityinternational.com</u> within 2 weeks of the trial. You will be able to log on to your account and see results that were clear rounds, gaining level points.

#### Not for Competition Runs

You may turn any run into a NFC run, but must declare this to the Judge as you are entering the ring. You must make sure the judge has acknowledged your NFC statement. You may use a non audible toy (NO food, NO clickers). You may use this time for any type of training, as long as you are not abusive to your dog. The handler will be given 60 seconds course time. If a handler chooses to train their startline, the time will be started once it becomes apparent you are doing so. You MUST leave the ring immediately once time is up. There will be no NFC food reward area at this trial.

## Maximum Course Time

All eliminations and NFC will be given a maximum course time of 60 seconds with the exception of Snooker and Gamblers. A single buzzer will sound at 50 seconds as a warning and 4 horns will sound at the 60 second mark, at which time you must leave the ring immediately. Snooker will be given SCT (first horn) and Gamblers will be given until the second horn.

Street Address for GPS/Google Maps: 45 Bella Vista Lane Barto, PA

• from Allentown, Harrisburg, Central New Jersey:

78 east or west to Allentown exit, Cedar Crest Blvd. South to Emmaus past hospital, at "T" turn right (Chestnut Street or Rt. 29 S) continue south on Rt.29 to Rt.100 South, continue to Hereford - 4 more miles to Bally. Middle of town is Longacre Electric (orange and blue sign) turn onto N. Church Street; go up hill approx. 1 mile. See pond on left side, turn left onto Bella Vista Lane. Continue on dirt drive until you see the agility buildings.

• From Pa. Turnpike:

NE extension to Quakertown exit bear right onto Rt. 663 S. (heading to Pennsburg) In Pennsburg, at Wendy's Flowers, intersection of Rt. 29, turn right onto Rt. 29 N to town of Hereford (Turkey Hill convenience store and light). Turn left onto Rt.100 S to town of Bally (continue as above).

• From Philadelphia:

Rt. 422 or 73 to Rt. 100 N to town of Bally. At Longacre's Electric, turn left onto North Church Street. Go approx. 1 mile; on left you'll see a pond, turn left on Bella Vista Lane; follow till you see agility buildings.
