Checking in

You do not need to check in unless you need to be measured and/or owe entry fees. **All entry fees must be paid prior to running your first class.** Failure to pay prior to running may jeopardize your results. **All competitors in each class must check in at the gate** by checking off their name on the call sheet. If you do not check in, the class will not wait for you. Please only check in for the class being walked. Please remember it is your responsibility to be ready at the ring for your run.

Mulligan Runs

Due to the number of entries, we will be offering mulligan runs on select courses this weekend. The cost will be \$5.00 each. You must have been entered in the class to participate in mulligan runs. There will be a sign up sheet on the gate board for you to write your name and jump height. You will have 60 seconds on course and can use a non-audible toy (no food). Trial Site Rules

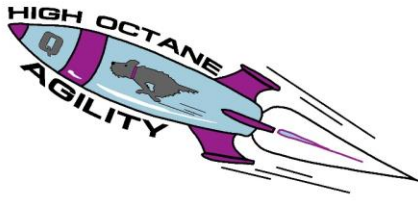
