Here are some important things to know...please be PATIENT with us-we are doing our best and we have not yet completed all that we want to do in our new space. If you have a kind suggestion, see Maureen.

## Where can I park?

We would like you to park on the left side (looking from the road) of the building closest to our door which is under the awning. Our logo is on the door. See Kelly, Maureen, or Jacky for any parking questions.

PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE 7 AM.

## What if there isn't any more parking on that side?

You can drive around the back and park on the right side of the building.

#### Where can I walk my dog?

You may walk your dog in front of our building between the building and the road. The road is busy, so please be careful. Do not walk your dog beyond our parking lot to the LEFT or beyond the parking lot on the right side of the building. The building parking lot does connect around the back and you may walk there, however you are walking at your own risk. Below is an "overhead view" of the property with areas color coded.



#### Is there crating inside?
