- If you are volunteering for ring crew (THANK YOU) – we will be leaving the 4” jumps in the jumps in the Green building all weekend. There will be a second set of cups for height changes
- If you are volunteering for course building (THANK YOU) – we do not bag the tunnels or put the bags up against the tunnels until the course has been tweaked. Basically, we only move the tunnel bags once (worker smarter not harder!). Putting the bags up against the tunnels before tweaking means they will need to be moved out of the way to adjust the tunnels
