Checking in

You do not need to check in unless you need to be measured and/or owe entry fees. All entry fees must be paid prior to running your first class. Failure to pay prior to running may jeopardize your results. **All competitors in each class must check in with the gate** by using the Agility Gate App. If you do not check in, the class will not wait for you. Please remember it is your responsibility to be ready at the ring for your run.

Online Results

Changing Handlers

Competitors are required to inform the trial secretary of any handler change. Please do so in a timely manner.

- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

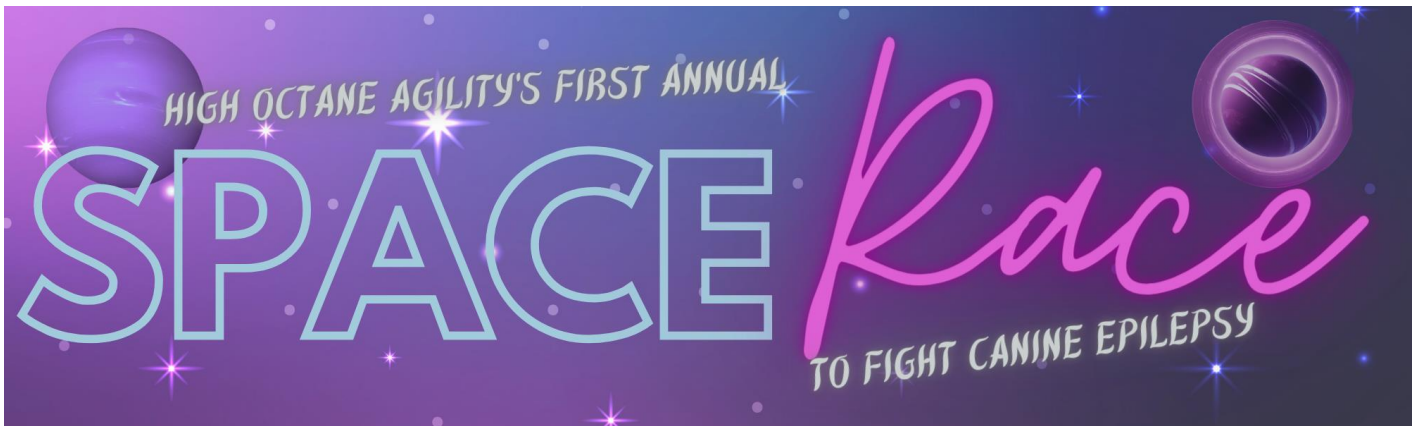

How it works....

- Each team will consist of 2 handlers and 2 dogs. The dogs can be from any level, any jump height or any height division (regular/select).
- The team event will consist of 1 agility round, 1 jumping round and 1 relay round (tunnelers)
 - The agility round will be designed to the guidelines for the senior level
 - The jumping round will be designed to the guidelines for the senior level
 - The relay round will consist of a course of tunnels only and will be designed to meet UKI course and safety guidelines
- Clear rounds in either of the Agility or Jumping classes will count towards the dog's level progression. Clear rounds in the relay class will not count towards any level progression, but will be SUPER FUN!
- No byes or certificates towards any future UKI event may be earned from participation in the High Octane Space Race
- \$20.00 for each team's entry fees will be donated to Canine Epilepsy Research

How does scoring work....

- Team scoring for the agility and jumping classes (scores from Agility 2 and Jumping 2 will not be used for team)
 - Each team begins with 200 points for each class
 - Dogs are scored on a time + faults basis
 - Eliminations will be scored as 50 faults
 - Each dog's score will be added together then subtracted from 200 points to form the team's score
- Relay
 - Each team starts with 300 points
 - First dog will run their part of the relay, while the handler is carrying a baton.
 - When the first dog crosses the finish line, handlers will exchange the baton in the designated area.
 - Second dog will run their part of the relay while the handler is carrying a baton.
 - Eliminations will be scored at 100 faults.
 - Team score will be 300 minus (time + faults).
- Overall Scoring
 - Scores from all 3 rounds will be added together
 - The team with highest score will be awarded 1st place



How to enter....

- Each team member will enter online via the UKI website
 - Enter Agility, Jumping, and the team relay classes on Saturday.
 - Cost for each class is \$15,
- One team member will visit the trial webpage on K9 Trial Services to fill out a team request form.
 - Enter first dog's name, registration #, handler name and handler registration #
 - Enter second dog's name, registration #, handler name and handler registration #
 - Enter Team Name. PG-13 names only please!!

Do I need to be on a team to enter....

- You may enter/run the Round 1 Agility and/or Round 1 Jumping class as if this was a normal trial. Clear rounds count towards level progression.
- You may enter/run the tunnelers course without being on a team. \$10 of your entry fee will be donated.
- You may enter the Team event as a "draw" with the understanding that if there is an odd number of "draws" you may not be placed on a team.
 - To enter as a draw, complete the "team request form" on K9 Trial Services website
 - Enter the your name, registration #, your dog's name and dog's registration #.
 - Enter "draw" as the information for all of the 2nd team member.
 - Enter "draw" as your team name.
