

Blast Off on Saturday, July 5th, for an out-of-this-world event as we launch our next mission to combat canine epilepsy! Teams (2 Dog & 2 Handlers/team) will soar through the cosmos, competing for glory across rounds of Agility, Jumping, and a pulse-pounding relay race featuring an all-tunnel course!

How it works....

- Each team will consist of 2 handlers and 2 dogs. The dogs can be from any level, any jump height or any height division (regular/select).
- The team event will consist of 1 agility round, 1 jumping round and 1 relay round
 - \circ $\;$ The agility round will be designed to the guidelines for the senior level
 - \circ $\;$ The jumping round will be designed to the guidelines for the senior level
 - The relay round will consist of a course of tunnels only and will be designed to meet UKI course and safety guidelines
- Clear rounds in either of the Agility or Jumping classes will count towards the dog's level progression. Clear rounds in relay class will not count towards any level progression
- No byes or certificates towards any future UKI event may be earned from participation in the High Octane Space Race
- \$20.00 from each team's entry fees will be donated to Canine Epilepsy Research

How does scoring work....

- Team scoring for the agility and jumping rounds
 - Each team begins with 200 points for each class
 - Dogs are scored on a time + faults basis
 - Eliminations will be scored at 50 faults
 - Each dog's score will be added together then subtracted from 200 points to form the team's score
- Relay
 - Each team starts with 300 points
 - First dog will run their part of the relay, while handler is carrying a baton.
 - When first dog crosses finish line, handlers will exchange the baton in designated area.
 - Second dog will run their part of the relay while handler is carrying a baton.
 - Eliminations will be scored at 100 faults.
 - Team score will 300 minus time + faults.
- Overall Scoring
 - Scores from all 3 rounds will be added together
 - \circ $\,$ Team with highest score will be awarded 1st place



How to enter....

- Each team member will enter online via the UKI website
 - Enter Round 1 Agility, Round 1 Jumping, and Team Relay classes on Saturday.
 - Cost for each class is \$16,
- One team member will visit the trial webpage on K9 Trial Services to fill out team request form.
 - Enter first dog's name, registration #, handler name and handler registration #
 - Enter second dog's name, registration #, handler name and handler registration #
 - Enter Team Name. PG-13 names only please!!

Do I need to be on a team to enter....

- You may enter/run the Round 1 Agility and/or Round 1 Jumping class as if this was a normal trial. Clear rounds count towards level progression.
- You may enter/run the tunnelers course without being on a team. \$10 of your entry fee will be donated.
- You may enter the Team event as a "draw" with the understanding that if there are an odd number of "draws" you may not be placed on a team.
