Mask Protocol

Masks are optional at all times.

Food Vendor

The Wounded Warrior Project will be providing food on Saturday (and Sunday). There are no food services on Friday.

Measuring Dogs

Measuring will take place near the check-in table prior to the first class. All dogs jumping below the 24 inch Championship height or the 20 inch Performance height must be measured unless you can show a permanent card from USDAA (from the dog's data page on the USDAA site), an AKC permanent card or two pages from UKI – the first page showing an asterisk beside the dog's height on the My Dogs page and then the second page after you click Edit for that dog that shows the dog's actual height. Either email me a pic of the AKC card or the two UKI pages, or bring me a paper copy, and I will submit to USDAA so that your dog will show as having a permanent height card in the USDAA system.

Parking/Crating

Crating is in the green building only. All parking is first come first served. Parking is in 2 areas; the first area is front of the red building 3 rows will fit here. There is no parking in front of these 3 rows or in front of the sheep pens. You may also park to the side of the green building in the old outdoor ring. Please do not move any cones or park in front of any cones.

Site Information

Orchard Hills is located on private property and is NOT open to the public outside of trial hours. DO NOT arrive at the trial site prior to stated times. Waiting in the driveway or on Church Street is not allowed. If you find yourself arriving early, there is a Turkey Hill and Wawa North on 100 and a Redner's and Dunkin Donuts South on 100.

Music will be played during walkthroughs and lightly during the running of classes.

Helpers

This is a one ring trial and helpers are not only appreciated but are necessary to conduct a smooth-running show. Please see us if you are able to help. We will have snacks and water available.

Course Maps, Gate Sheets and Real Time Results

We will not be providing paper course maps. Course Maps, Running Orders and Results are available at www.k9trialservices.com. The preliminary running order will be published by Thursday morning. Course maps will be published by 9PM Saturday.

In an attempt to cut down on areas of congestion, we will be utilizing the Agility Gate app, developed by Roger Ly. This app can be downloaded and used on both android and IOS devices. The app allows you to check in or scratch from your device. You can also check to see which dog is currently running. You can download the app from your appropriate app store.

Not for Competition Runs

As of September 4, 2024, the following amendments have been made to the FEO Policy:

- FEO is not permitted in any tournament class at any event
- You must notify the Gate Steward, Scribe and Judge
- Non-audible toys are allowed. Treats or food are not permitted
- The judge will remain in the ring to monitor the run
- The competitor may not carry into the ring any additional equipment or props, or the aid of other persons
- The general sequence of the course should be followed as set forth by the course plan
